



Waitakere City FC Advancement Tournament U11 & U12

Location: Fred Taylor Park, 184 Fred Taylor Drive, Whenuapai

Date: Sunday 18th October 2020

Waitakere City FC is excited to host all 11th and 12th grade teams, participating in our annual Advancement Tournament. As its coming to the end of the season and looking forward to next year in 12th & 13th grade respectively, this will be a great opportunity for teams to play using next years rules, team size and field size. This is a great introduction to 2021 and a fun way to say good bye to 2020.

Tournament Format:

Tournament Model.

- The teams will play a round robin with a Championship final series, with each team playing at least 4 games.
- Games will be played on 1/2 pitch fields of approx 75m x 55m (11th grade) and full field (12th grade) and will both use a size 4 ball.
- 9 players per team including the goalkeeper to be on the pitch at any one time for all 11th grade teams. All players must be born in 2009 and be registered to a club as a 11th grade player in 2020.
- 11 players per team including the goalkeeper to be on the pitch at any one time for all 12th grade teams. All players must be born in 2008 and be registered to a club as a 12th grade player in 2020.
- Teams may have as many subs as required but should try not to exceed 5.
- Substitutions are rolling and can happen as often as is required.
- Team managers must report to the registration tent by 8:30 am with a managers briefing followed by a teams briefing at 8:45 am.
- First games kick off at 9:00 am with prize giving for all the teams to be approx 2:30pm
- Pool games will be 26mins - 2x 12min halves with a 2min break for halftime.
- Finals will be 32mins - 2x 15min halves with a 2min break for halftime.

Pool Play & Playoffs.

Pool play for 11th grade will be organised in one pool of all teams. This means each team will play each other team. Pool play for 12th grade teams will be split into 2x pools of 4 teams.

Pool play matches will be 12 minutes each way, with a 2-minute half time break (timing will be indicated by the hooter). There will be no extra time for pool play. The game finishes on the hooter.

In pool play, a team will earn 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and no points for a loss.

When calculating eligibility for playoffs and points are tied, teams will be ranked goal difference, then total goals scored and then head to head result. If teams are still even, then total number of wins will be used.

Playoffs.

Finals will be on a knock out basis. To find the final placements, after all pool games for 11th grade, the top two teams will play for 1st and 2nd. The next two for 3rd and 4th.

Semi finals and Finals for the 12th grade competition will be as per the draw.

Finals games will also be 15 minutes each way, with a 2-minute half time break (timing will be indicated by the hooter).

If scores are tied at the end of the match, then a penalty shootout will take place.

The penalty shootout is taken 7 meters from goal, and three selected players on the field at full time having a turn. The team with the most goals scored is the winner. If the scores are still tied after three players, then the penalty shootout continues with sudden death applying. The remaining players in the squad must be used before the original three take a further penalty.



Referees.

The refereeing of all pool, Quarter finals and Semi final games is to be shared between both teams just like the regular season. The home team (as per the draw) will ref the first half and the away team ref the second half.

WCFC will supply referees for the finals in both 11th and 12th grade.

Tournament Logistics.

Draws & Results.

The tournament draws for the 11th and 12th grade will be issued before the tournament (Should be found below). The organiser reserves the right to change the advanced draws if there are late withdrawals of teams.

After each match, both teams need to submit score cards to the admin tent where results and tables will be displayed. Play off finalists and fields will be announced over the PA system and displayed on the results board at the admin tent.

Prize-giving will be held approx 3.30pm and prizes awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd place teams.

Match Rules.

The following rules will be followed for all 11th and 12th grade matches:

- The retreating line rule will be marked and the regulation must be followed for all 11th grade teams (attacking team will move behind the retreating line until the defending team touches the ball - No offsides before the retreating line). All 12th grade teams will follow full field offside rules.
- Corner kicks will be taken from within 1m of the corner.
- Throw-ins should be taken correctly - two feet on the ground, ball behind the head.
- Tackles from behind, dangerous and jump-in tackles - a free kick to be awarded.
- Deliberate hand-ball - a free kick to be awarded.
- If a free kick is awarded in the penalty area, (10 metre square area in front of goal for 11th grade, 12th grade goalkeepers area), a penalty is to be awarded.
- A penalty is to be taken 7 metres from the goal.
- Other match rules will follow normal FIFA rules, and the referee's decision is final.

Postponement / Cancellation.

In the current climate of Covid 19, the event postponement/cancellation is a possibility, we will contact all managers/coaches using the contact details provided on the tournament entry form.

Tournament Day Logistics.

There will be a Coaches Briefing at 8.30am at the Admin Tent, next to the club, and any revised match details will be provided. We will also go over all rules to make sure all teams understand. The attached map indicates the location of the admin tent, first aid tent & position for team gazebos if required.

Food & Refreshments

The attached map also shows where the tuck shop / kitchen is located, these will be selling refreshments and hot food for most of the day.



Tournament Ethos.

This tournament is designed to help familiarise all players to the type of football they will face when we return in 2021. It is going to be new to some players so this tournament needs to be a fun place for everyone to learn and experience good football.

This is not the end of season nationals, and even as a post-season tournament there may be teams that have not played this level of football previously, so please be mindful when coming up against teams of different skill levels and experience.

Team members and supporters should be reminded of what is acceptable behaviour. Abusive, derogatory or racist language will not be tolerated. WCFC reserves the right to exclude or expel supporters, members of teams or whole teams that continuously display negative behaviour.

Response to Covid-19.

As this is a serious threat to our game, we will be providing all the necessary precautions for teams to limit any possibility of spreading the illness.

ALL attendees MUST sign in to Fred Taylor Park using the government tracing app and QR code (below).

Elbow bumps or ghost high fives are the expected during end of game sportsmanship.

If any team member is unwell on the day or the week prior, please do not attend the tournament.

There will be hand sanitiser stations around the park to keep our hands clean and changing rooms and toilets will all be open and cleaned for players to use.

Masks are an effective way to limit the spread of germs so we do ask that spectators feel free to wear them and players when not on the field of play also.

All attendees are asked to maintain social distancing where possible. There will be spaces for team gazebos and again please use common sense to keep our social distance when setting these up.

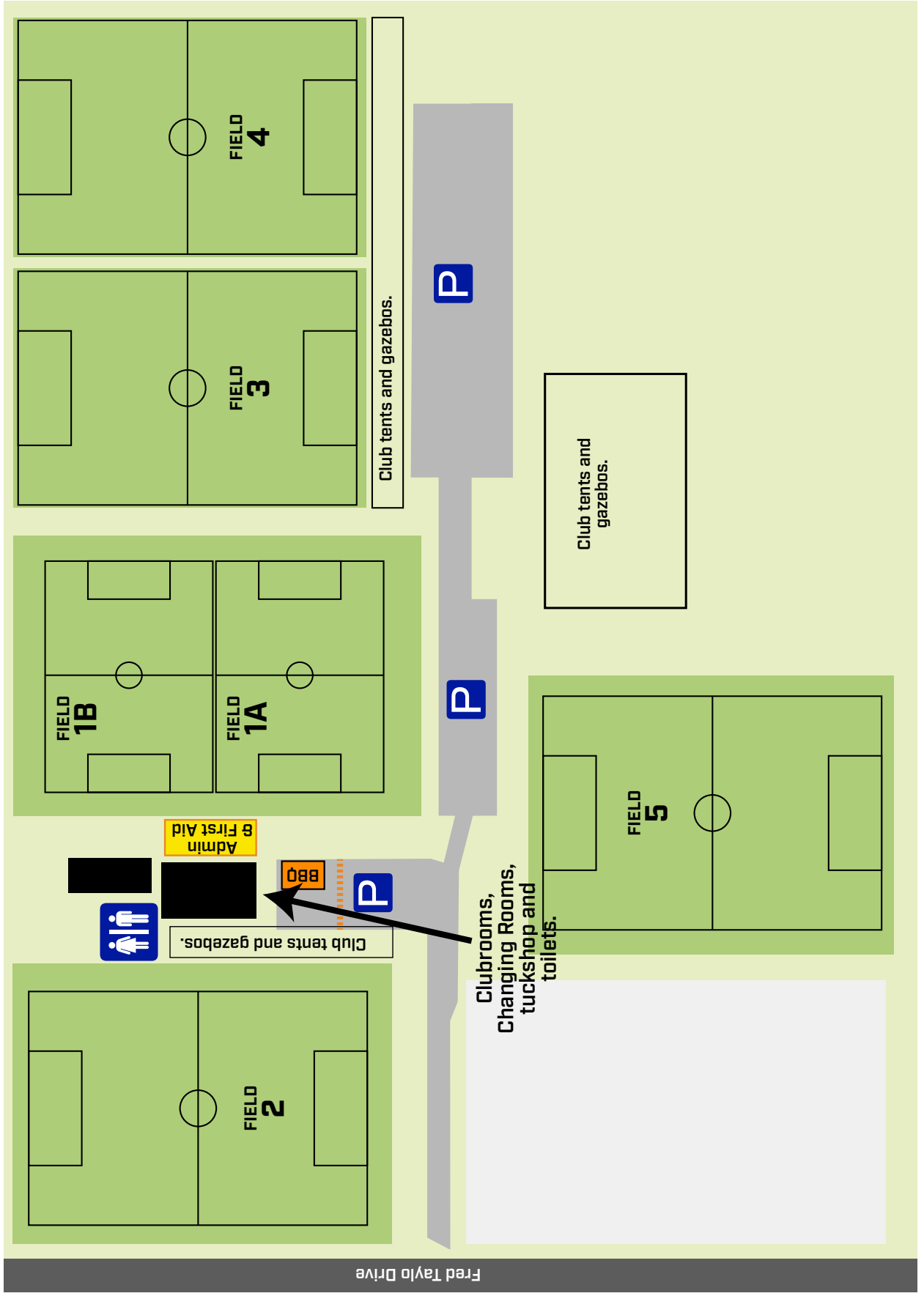
